JUBILEE YEAR - The Church has started a special year - The Jubilee of Hope running from Advent 2024 through to Epiphany 2026. The concept of Jubilee or ‘Holy Year’ has been used to proclaim special years for forgiveness and reconciliation. Most recently the Great Jubilee was declared in 2000 to celebrate the new millennium. The 2025 Jubilee Year has the theme of ‘Pilgrims of Hope’ and is a year of hope and trust for our world suffering from the many impacts of war, the aftermath of the Covid pandemic and climate change. It is a good time to visit St Peter’s in Rome, our own Cathedral in Portsmouth or another Church designated by our Diocesan Bishop – the nearest to us is the Church of the Sacred Heart in the centre of Bournemouth. By faithfully participating in the Holy Year, you are granted a plenary indulgence. There are six Jubilee themes in Holy Scripture that we can explore : 1. Care for Creation, 2. Food Poverty, 3. Modern Slavery, 4. Managing Debt, 5. Forgiveness, 6. Rest and Worship. Further information and events to follow.
