These alarms are wall mounted and have an easy push button system to alert everyone should a fire occur. Please make yourself aware of the alarms and please do discuss them with family members to ensure that everyone is aware of their location and also to reiterate that they are strictly for emergencies only, to tamper with them may cause undue shock & upset to those in close proximity as the alarms are incredibly loud.
