**ANNUNCIATION CHURCH PROJECT** - At long last we have been given the approval for work to commence at the Annunciation Church on three specific areas. After applying for Faculties due to the Annunciation being a 2\* Listed Building, the Architect then drew up a specification of works which has now been tendered and the final permission granted by the Diocese for work to begin. The project which follows on from the major outside restoration project will include the decoration of the interior of the Church, the construction of a disability toilet with baby changing facilities alongside a standard toilet at the rear of the church. The third part of the project is the upgrade to the handrail in the Choir gallery to comply with health and safety regulations. The whole project will obviously cause some upheaval and the church will be closed for 6-8 weeks with No access.

Sunday Masses will take place in the Church Hall and all weekday Masses will take place at St Edmund Campion Church. A more specific timetable will be published once contractors have agreed a work schedule.

**NEW LECTIONARY** - The Lectionary - the books that contain the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments is changing this autumn as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations which makes them more faithful to their original languages, more suitable for liturgical settings and where appropriate more inclusive. The new Lectionary will become mandatory for use in all Churches in England and Wales from the beginning of Advent 2024. Books are costly and we need to purchase 1 lectern set , 1 Book of the Gospels and 100 peoples Mass Books for each Church. The Mass setting is not changing only the readings and psalms. One Lectern set (4 books) with the Book of the Gospels is £970 ( which hopefully will be used for the next 20 years) and replacing the Sunday Mass Books will cost £990 a year for the next 3 years – Year A vol 1&2 , Year B vol 1&2 , Year C vol 1&2 for each Church. If you would like to contribute towards this expense or even give a set of Books in memory of a loved one, please speak with Fr Anthony or Deacon Barry.

**SUNDAY COUNTING ROTA** - Would you be able to help count the offeratory cash collection once every 6-8weeks? We are in need of 2 people so we can create another team. It would require you to be at the presbytery at 6pm on the allocated Sunday and you would leave around 7.30pm. We are currently down to 3 teams of two to three people who undertake the counting process. Please contact the parish office if you are able to assist or for more information.

**HOPE FOR FOOD - URGENT FOOD DONATIONS** - If anyone is able to donate tinned items, dried goods, sweet biscuits, jam & any children's treats for the school holidays they would be gratefully received. There are boxes at the back of both churches, these will be kindly delivered to Hope For Food by one of our parishioners.

**OUR PARISH** - Our Parish is always looking for volunteers to help to support the Clergy. We currently require Fire Wardens for each Sunday Mass but wish to thank those who have offered their help in other areas, we really appreciate it.

**VERY IMPORTANT - GIFT AID** - Due to changes to the Diocese's Charity name HMRC has insisted that all those enrolled in our Gift Aid Scheme now complete and sign a new declaration form. Gift Aid is an integral part of our Parish income so please complete a new form and return it to the Sacristy or the Parish Office asap. If you donate to the parish by direct debit, standing order, cheque, bank transfer, card or cash and you pay Income TAX then we can claim the tax back from the government at no extra cost to you. Forms are available at the back of both churches.
