WHAT IS RCIA? - RCIA, which stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, is a process through which non-baptised men and women are welcomed into the Catholic Church. It involves several stages marked by study, prayer, and rites celebrated during Mass. Participants in the RCIA are known as catechumens. It is also available to individuals who were baptised but then did not participate in or received limited faith formation. Our course will commence later this year, please contact the parish if you are interested in joining this program.
